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Every effort has been made to produce what epitomizes "The Golden Retriever" – healthy, gentle, friendly and loving structurally correct puppies and companions – the temperament and character that is the "hallmark" of the breed.

The dogs used in the breeding program have all of their clearances. X-rays of both hips and elbows have been taken and certified through OFA. Eye certifications have been performed (annually) by a board certified ophthalmologist. Hearts have been checked and cleared by a board certified cardiologist.

If there is reasonable doubt, in the breeder's opinion, as to the suitability of the depositor, the deposit will be returned in Full. If you have given a deposit for a puppy and your circumstances change and you do not wish or are unable to purchase a puppy, the deposit will be returned in Full. The price of a puppy is \$2,200.00. A deposit of \$300.00 will be required to reserve a puppy for your family. The deposit shall be given in US funds two weeks after the litter is whelped. Please be advised, that while every effort has been made to ensure a healthy puppy, there are no guarantees – implied or otherwise.
